INSTRUCTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

Instructional arrangements within a school or within a classroom are the responsibility of each Building Principal, with input provided by the respective staff. The aim is to place each student in an appropriate and comfortable learning situation.

Provision for individual differences shall be given high priority in planning the instructional program, in choosing teaching methods and materials, and in evaluating results.

Class size

The Superintendent shall work closely with Building Principals in establishing a reasonable teacher-student ratio in each building.

Team Teaching

Teachers may team teach upon approval of the Superintendent or a designee.
