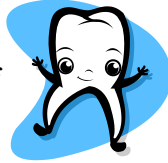

MANDATORY DENTAL EXAMS

The deadline for the dental exam forms is fast approaching. All Kindergarten and second grade students are required to have a dental exam. If you have not already turned in your dental forms to the office please do so by Friday, May 15th. We have waiver forms in the office if needed. For frequently asked questions you may visit the Illinois State Dental Society's website at www.ISDS.org. The Tazewell County Health Department also has a low cost dental clinic located in North Pekin. You may contact the TCHD at 925-5511. Children who do not have a form on file may not receive their final report card. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.



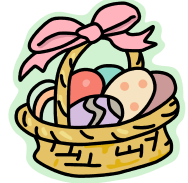
MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS

All children entering school at any grade level (Kindergarten through 12th) shall show proof of having received two doses of live rubella and mumps virus vaccine (MMR). Students entering Kindergarten, 6th or 9th grade for the first time shall show proof of having received two doses of varicella vaccine or other proof of immunity shall be submitted. The proof must come from the physician. Any child entering a school program below the Kindergarten level shall show proof of immunization that complies with the pneumococcal conjugate vaccine.

Remember also that all students entering Kindergarten, 6th, and 9th grade must have an Illinois physical. Dental examinations are required for students entering kindergarten, 2nd, and 6th grade. Sixth graders must show proof of the Tdap immunization. An eye examination is required by the State for children entering Kindergarten.

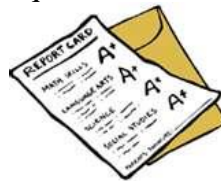
EARLY DISMISSAL SPRING BREAK
