**Early Dismissal** – on Friday March 22 there will be a one hour early dismissal. Parkview School will dismiss at 1:35 marking the beginning of Spring Break. Spring Monday, April 1st.

**8<sup>th</sup> Grade Promotion Ceremony**– will be held on Thursday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> at East Peoria High School at 6:30 p.m. Students must be there by 5:45 p.m. More information will be sent home about the ceremony and class picture at a later date. Gowns will be here sometime in April and will be sent home with the students after they are fitted by a Jostens representative. Remember, all fees need to be paid and uniforms need to be turned in before May 1st or your child will not be eligible to go to Six Flags or go through the promotion ceremony. The trip has been scheduled for Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>. The last day of school for the 8<sup>th</sup> grade is May 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**Athletic Awards** - Awards night will be held on April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 6:00pm in the Gym. The following sports will be honored: Baseball, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Girls and Boys Basketball, Volleyball, Warriorettes and Cheerleading.

**Report Cards** – were sent home on March 15<sup>th</sup>. If you have any questions, please call your child's teacher. Make sure you sign and return the report card. Congratulations to the students that made the honor roll the 3<sup>rd</sup> nine weeks. Mid-term grades end April 10<sup>th</sup> and will be sent home on April 17<sup>th</sup>

**Medical Files – Requirements for 2019-2020 school year.** All children entering school at any grade level (kindergarten through 12) must show proof of having received two doses of live rubella and mumps virus vaccine (MMR). Students entering Kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> grade for the first time shall show proof of having received two doses of varicella vaccine or other proof of immunity must be submitted. The proof must come from the physician or health department. Remember also that all students entering kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> grade must have a physical. Dental examinations are required for students entering kindergarten, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Sixth graders must show proof of the Tdap immunization and (MCV) Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccination. An eye examination is required by the State for children entering kindergarten and new students to the state.

**IAR Testing** – took place for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade on March 12-14<sup>th</sup> and for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade on March 19<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>. *Federal law requires the Illinois State Board of Education to administer certain assessments to all students who attend public schools in the state, including students who attend charter schools. According to federal law, Students must take an achievement exam in reading / language arts and mathematics each year from 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. In Illinois, students must take the IAR exam. Federal and state law does not authorize districts or schools to excuse students from testing.*
